Rocky River Teacher Dorothy Gray Dies

Memorial services for Dorothy Gray, an English teacher at Rocky River High School before she retired in 1962, will be in the chapel of Plymouth Church of Shaker Heights (United Church of Christ), Coventry and Weymouth roads, at 3 p.m. Saturday.

Miss Gray taught at Rocky River High for 31 years.

She died Tuesday in Belmore Manor Extended Care Facility, 1835 Belmore Road, East Cleveland.

Miss Gray, born in Cleveland, was graduated from the former College for Women, now part of Western Reserve College of Case Western Reserve University, and received her master's degree from WRU.

She had been a volunteer worker in fund campaigns for the United Appeal, now the United Torch Services, and worked with students who also were volunteers in the fund campaigns.

Miss Gray also was a volunteer in the Women's Association for Church World Service at Plymouth Church.
