EDITH AINSLEY WHITE, 87, TAUGHT IN ROCKY RIVER

Edith Ainsley White taught high school for more than 40 years.

Ms. White, 87, died Tuesday in Lakewood of congestive heart failure. She was born in Elyria. She received her bachelor's degree from Baldwin-Wallace College and her master's degree from Columbia University. Later she taught at Valley City High School for five years and taught math and speech at Rocky River High School for 37 years.

Ms. White was active with the Lakewood United Methodist Church until a stroke confined her to a wheelchair in 1974.

She is survived by a nephew, Dr. Edward C. White of Berea; a niece, Elizabeth C. Radcliffe of Reston, Va.; and a close friend, Louise Beck of Rocky River.
